The east bank of the Bottom Dam and the Henley Drive entrance to Hamilton Park were also cleared extensively and this area looks terrific. The Arboretum garden was also well weeded, areas around sheds were cleared and some tree branches were also removed.

At the subsequent working bee on 11 November, volunteers continued to tidy up the many drains and culverts, and to mow other areas of the park.
