Update on Hamilton Park water storage

We have implemented **Stage 2 water restrictions** and you will have received a flyer in your mail box. As we don't expect that we will have any significant inflows to the system from rain for the next two months, and we cannot pump from 15 Mile Creek until June, we ask that everyone remain considerate of the low dam water levels when using water in the next few weeks.

Please report any **pipeline leaks** to the **HP mobile 0490 809 341 ASAP**. Also **please check water fittings** in your property to ensure there are no leaking pipes or taps. This is critical to ensure we retain enough **water for fire protection** and **minimal resident use** over the coming months.

Cats in Hamilton Park

The Board owns a humane Feral Cat trap, which can be hired out to residents. The cat trap may be booked in advance and collected from the Bob Bracken shed. The hire fee is \$50 which is refunded fully on return of the trap in good condition.

Any resident hiring the cat trap will be asked to sign an information sheet to ensure humane treatment of a trapped cat. Hamilton Park's policy aligns with Rural City of Wangaratta policy
