What do Stage Two water restrictions mean?

Hand watering

Use a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle. **Residential lawns cannot be watered at any time.**

Watering systems

You can water gardens using a watering system (manual, automatic, spray or dripper) **only on alternate days** between 6am – 8am and 6pm – 8pm.

As this summer is predicted to be dry, it is of great importance that residents use water sparingly in their gardens. Please note that Stage Two (2) water restrictions remain in
