What are STAGE 2 Water Restrictions

Lawns areas must not be watered at any time

Residents can only use a manual watering system on *alternate days* between the hours of 6:00am and 8:00am and 8:00pm and 10:00pm

Automatic watering systems can only be used on *alternate days* between the hours of midnight and 4:00am

Gardens may be watered using a *hand held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, watering can or bucket at anytime.*
