Tree felling is being undertaken on this site as part of an ecological thinning program through the Bush for Birds project.

The Bush for Birds Project is supported by Trust for Nature and the North East Catchment Management Authority through funding from the Australian Government's National Landcare Program.

Ecological thinning is the selective removal of trees within a dense patch in order to promote the growth of large old trees, which are an important nectar resource for birds including the critically endangered Regent Honeyeater and Swift Parrot.

A conservation work exemption has been obtained from DELWP in order to comply with the Native Vegetation Removal Regulations.
