JOB TO DO	DESCRIPTION
Remove/dab weeds	Weedy shrubs, weedy wattles, Bridal creeper, Nightshade, Privet, Briar rose, Asparagus, Wonga vine etc
Rabbit action	Continue checking. Prevent any active burrows
Eco-thinning	Continue with Euc blakelyi removal
Monitoring	Generally, throughout Common Land
Spot spraying	Paspalum, Phalaris when seed heads emerge (before seed fall)

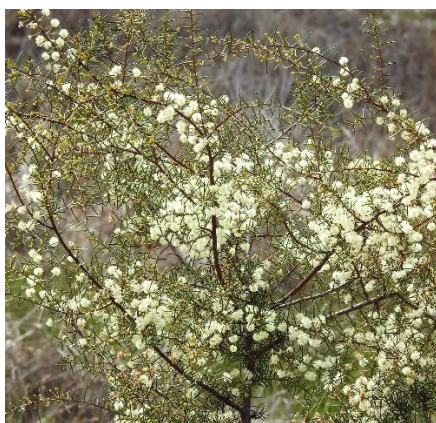

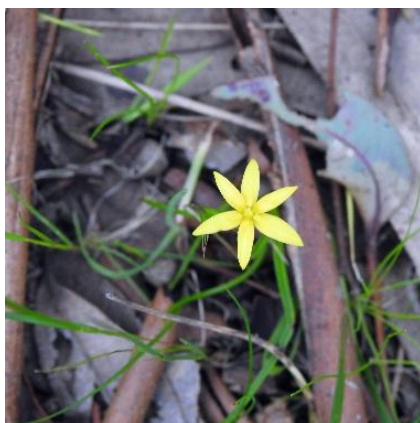
